**CPF submissions using hardcopy forms for e-registered employers to cease from 2021**

Today, over nine in ten employers enjoy the convenience of submitting and paying their CPF contributions electronically, anytime, anywhere. To encourage more employers to go digital and in line with Singapore's Smart Nation initiatives, CPF Board will no longer accept hardcopy CPF submissions from employers who are registered for CPF e-Submission from 1 January 2021.

From our records, you have registered for CPF e-Submission. If you have been submitting your CPF contributions electronically, please continue to do so.

From 1 January 2021, hardcopy CPF submissions would not be processed and any payment made together with the submission will be refunded to you within 30 days. If you fail to re-submit your CPF contributions (for the contribution month) by the 14<sup>th</sup> of the following month (or the next working day if the 14<sup>th</sup> falls on a Saturday, Sunday or Public Holiday), enforcement actions may be taken. This includes imposing late payment interest of 1.5% per month starting from the first day of the following month.
